Last year, AMB launched its first annual giving campaign. It ran from November 31st through December 31st. And, with your contribution and support, we raised almost \$30,000.00! And, with your responses to our request, you helped to clarify the need for we as citizens to band together to address violence with innovative solutions that we build ourselves, in our own communities. Again, thank you.

Now, this year, 2022, we are launching the "Creating Peace in the Neighborhood." But, due to COVID19, we have made adjustments to our campaign calendar and activities. Many of our workshops, clinics and rallies are moving on-line! The peace-making weekends will now begin in May, dependent on clearance of the pandemic (we will use caution, because we want our people to be safe).



We are expecting to attract and work with at least 20,000 young people nation-wide this year. They will learn to deescalate tension; learn how to lead peace rallies, marches and the crafting of resolution talk-outs. And, we are looking forward to launch these efforts in the cities where we have a presence.

And, with their energy, their innovative thought in this technical age and their need to grow past many obstacles of our communities, they will "see visions", learn to carry the message of peace and build that peace we all seek! With our young on the front-lines, we will realize the peace that many have only dreamed about - a peaceful community, with equal justice, much less poverty, without racial hate and senseless killings!





"COVID-19 Clinic Without Walls"

Rev. Kyev Tatum, Pastor of New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church in Forth Worth, Texas and founder of Covid-19 Clinic Without Walls, has received the 2022 Community Partner Award from the joint Workforce Development Board and Workforce Governing Board's Meeting & Awards program.



Pastor Tatum, along with his congregation, are working in collaboration with FEMA, DHHS, Moncrief Cancer Institute, Texas Emergency Management and Ministers of Justice Coalition of Texas, are distributing over one million cloth masks, 26,000 KN95 masks. And, 10 million dollars in USDA Farm to Families fresh food boxes and over \$250,000 other PPE supplies and treatment from private companies are being distributed.

Today, the Clinic Without Walls is distributing PPE's in twenty-two Texas cities, including Forth Worth, Waco, Austin and Dallas.
